

Safety Guide

Get “Certified.” Certification is required for individual use of some equipment. Contact DDR Staff to arrange training.

Focus. Do not distract others or let yourself be distracted when using tools/equipment.

Keep hands, fingers, and hair away from blades or other moving parts of equipment.

Maintain a safe work area.

- ✓ Keep area free of debris and clutter while working.
- ✓ When using blades, always close or cover the blade, if possible, when not in use.
- ✓ Let hot items cool before handling.
- ✓ Clean up and return tools after you are finished working.

Wear proper attire & safety equipment.

- ✓ Use appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as needed.
- ✓ Tie back long hair and avoid dangling jewelry or scarves.
- ✓ Wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the activity performed.
- ✓ Keep sharp tools out of pockets.

Notify staff if you experience an injury or if a tool or piece of equipment isn't working right.

Supervise minors. Active supervision is highly encouraged for families of all ages. Kids under 13 require active supervision by an adult Member. Watch for programs specifically planned for younger kids.
